

Installation Instructions & Use Recommendations

FMS Accessories – Flag Pole Mount

These instructions must be read carefully and thoroughly **before** beginning work. FMS Solutions, LLC accepts no liability for damage caused by failure to observe the installation instructions or use recommendations.

Installation of this accessory does not change the factory specified load limits for the motorcycle.

Warning: Flags cause instability while riding. Operation with a flag mounted in the flag pole mount is only for slow speed parade use. An unfurled flag will cause instability to the motorcycle, depending upon the size of the flag, ambient wind speed, etc. Operation should be restricted to less than 15 mph. Flags should be furled when parked as wind influence on an unfurled flag could cause the motorcycle to be blown over. Flags / pole should be removed from the mount and secured when riding faster than 15 MPH.




Attach the four M6 clip nuts to the RH saddlebag frame as shown in the photo at right.



Bolt the flag pole mount to the four clip nuts using the M6 washer-head Torx screws provided using a T30 driver. You may wish to apply a small amount of anti-seize compound to the threads of the bolt to prevent galling – particularly if the mount will be removed and reinstalled periodically.

Tight securely.

The M6 black knob set-screw is provided to secure the 1.25" diameter flag pole in the tube. Check the tension of the set-screw periodically when riding in parades to ensure that the flag is securely mounted.



Attach the additional warning label to the top edge of the lower portion of the RH saddlebag so that it is not blocked by contents or bag liners and is visible to the rider each time the saddlebag is opened.

Attach this instruction sheet to the invoice and ensure that the rider is aware of the warnings regarding operation and parking with a flag mounted.



The flag pole mount is constructed of stainless steel and should require no maintenance other than keeping it clean. A cap is provided to improve the appearance when a flag is not in use.

Note: Make certain to tighten the M6 knob set-screw bolt all the way to reduce the likelihood of the knob coming loose when no flag is mounted. Alternatively, you may wish to keep the knob in the saddlebag when no flag is mounted.

FMS Solutions, LLC will determine if the FMS accessory has a warrantable defect, and if so, will repair or replace the item and return it to the sender without charge. The decision to repair or replace said item is solely the prerogative of FMS Solutions, LLC.
